
Eagle Hall, Lincs.

Alongside these there are a growing number of pheasant drives utilising the varied topography around a large, central, established woodland. In tandem with outlying spinneys and copses this beat provides great sport.

All days at Eagle Hall begin at the recently refurbished shoot lodge, offering a comfortable space to catch up with old friends and enjoy a coffee before heading to the first drive in the brand new gun bus.
